Due to extreme weather in BC has resulted in flash flooding and mudslides which have compromised all major rail and road thoroughfares in and out of BC.

The 2 major highways - Highway 1 (Trans-Canada Highway) and Highway 5 (Coquihalla Highway) will continue to remain closed for the foreseeable future. We are awaiting updates on the only other option, which is Highway 3 (Hope Princeton).

This routing will add considerably to the transit time compared to our normal routes, which utilizes highway 5 and highway 1. We anticipate delays in service of one or more days and additional costs as well. The following surcharge will apply when the alternative routing is used and is to compensate for the extra hours and miles involved.

**Cost recovery surcharge of \$1.90 per cwt (min \$25.00, max \$580.00, per shipment) will be added to all shipments until further notice.**

This surcharge will apply to any freight moving to and from Vancouver from any of our service centers within BC or AB.

Please note the Kicking Horse Canyon closure surcharge is still in effect.

We look forward to returning to normal operations and will keep you informed as we move forward.
