

KICKING HORSE CANYON CONSTRUCTION & ROAD CLOSURES SURCHARGE

As you are aware, the closure on Highway 1 at Kicking Horse Pass near Golden, BC, was scheduled to open on June 1, 2021.

The latest update on the progress of the construction project is that the closure will continue overnight full closures and intermittent 1 lane traffic when open during the day, therefore our surcharge will remain in effect.

During these closures, traffic will be detoured through Radium, BC. Kindly anticipate delays for shipments moving between British Columbia and Alberta.

We will make all efforts to limit service disruptions and mitigate delays while remaining compliant with federally regulated Hours of Service rules.

For the duration of this project, all LTL shipments moving long this detour will have a surcharge of 5% to a maximum of \$150 (plus taxes) applied and all full loads will have a surcharge of \$150 (plus taxes) applied.
